Talk on the below points:

6. How do you handle your child's failures or setbacks?

Here, it's important to express your point of view in a positive manner.

- Talk about the importance of resilience and learning from failures
- Emphasize your role in providing emotional support and guidance.

7. What extracurricular activities does your child enjoy?

Mentions about the activities which is loved by your child.

- Highlight any hobbies or activities your child is passionate about
- Express openness to exploring new activities within the school

8. How do you ensure a balance between academics and extracurricular activities?

Stress the importance of a balanced lifestyle, where both academics and extracurricular activities contribute to holistic development. Mention a structured schedule.

9. What Are Your Educational Qualifications?

This school interview question for parents is asked to assess how invested parents are in their child's education. The school could also wish to see how you plan to use your educational background to nurture your child's future.

10. Have You Ever Punished Your Child? Why and How?

This would be to assess what your approach to discipline is and if it matches the school's standing. Of course, as a parent, you are entitled to discipline your child a certain way and demand they do so differently. They will also gain insight into any disciplinary issues your child may have.
